### DEPOSIT & CANCELLATIONS

We require a 50% non-refundable deposit for all reservations to be paid within 7 days of making reservation. The balance due at check out. Deposits are not refundable; Cancellations made at least 30 days prior to your intended arrival remain active and can be applied to a future reservation for up to one (1) year from the original planned arrived date. NO REFUNDS! We will transfer your deposit one (1) time only, which means if you cannot attend the date that you have transferred your deposit to, you lose your deposit. You may cancel your reservation by phone or letter. DO NOT CANCEL BY E-MAIL. A \$25.00 CANCELLATION FEE WILL BE DEDUCTED FROM YOUR DEPOSIT.

### **WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW**

Wi-Fi in main Lodge

You will need to bring your own feed, hay, water bucket, stall cleaning tools and tack for your horse.

It is advisable to bring a raincoat, rubber boots.

Meals will be served between 8am and 9am for breakfast and 6pm dinner, organized rides dinner 6 pm to 8 pm.

Our electric hookups are 30-amp breaker.

All scheduled events are limited to registered guests only.

Memorial Day, 4<sup>th</sup> of July and Labor Day are considered Holiday weekends.

Dog owners will be held financial responsible for damage to Brushy Creek property.

We have a centrally located dump-station.

Rider weight limit for rental horses is 250 lbs.

Children must be supervised by an adult at all times.

Folks staying in Tee-Pee will supply own bedding.

Shower/restroom facilities are equipped with mirrors, sinks and electrical outlets for hair dryers.

Beginning at 11pm and continuing until 6am no loud noises or riding. Be mindful of your neighbors.

Reservations are strongly suggested for all or our services, We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone.
